2011-2012 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Reading Goal: 93% of students will meet or exceed the reading standards as measured by ISAT.

Subgoals:

1. Align Reading Core with Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions through sequences of content.
2. Increase the number of students who are meeting their independent reading goals.

Writing Goal: 90% of students will meet or exceed the writing standards as measured by Metritech.

Subgoals:

1. Align writing terminology across grade levels.
2. Students will score their own writing and track their writing progress in data folders from their initial sample to best yet.
3. Teachers will score writing samples once a week using random sampling.
4. Teachers will grade every students' writing on every third sample—this will be basis of the Language / Arts grade.

Math Goal: 93% of students will meet or exceed the standards on the 2011 ISAT.

Subgoals:

1. Improve student mastery of multi-step word problems.

Discipline and School Climate: School discipline and climate will improve according the following benchmarks.

- A. Reductions of fights as compared with last year.
- B. Numbers of office referrals by month per classroom.
- C. Student and Staff Survey data.

Subgoals:

1. Each homeroom teacher teaches Second Step curriculum for 15 minutes / day.
2. Implement a 3-tier problem-solving process for solving special-cause discipline problems.

College-Bound Culture: Meet the criteria for acceptance into the No Excuses University Network.

Subgoals:

1. Each classroom will adopt a college or university.
2. Embed discussions about colleges and university throughout the curriculum.
